Pre-COVID, she also participated in a mock mass casualty event at Masonic Villages in Lancaster County.

#### WELCOME TO VIOLET DE STEFANO



Violet De Stefano is a new Emergency Health Service Federation (EHSF)/SCPA MRC employee, serving as Deputy Unit Leader reporting to our Unit Leader, Brittney Fuhrman. As a Public Health Specialist, she will work to bridge the gap between public health and emergency medical services. This includes supporting the SCPA MRC, the South-Central PA Immunization Coalition, and the Public Health Division of EHSF.

# COMMUNITY WELLBEING: WATER SAFETY

Swimming is fun and a great way to keep cool, but it's important to know how to stay safe in and around water.

Drowning is swift and silent – there may be little splashing or cries for help. It can take as few as 20 seconds to sink below the water and only minutes to drown whether around a pond, lake, river, ocean, or pool.

The National Safety Council and National Drowning Prevention Alliance recommend the following <u>few safety precautions</u>:

- Don't go in the water unless you know how to swim; swim lessons are available for all ages.
- Make sure the body of water matches your skill level. Swimming in a pool is much different than swimming in a lake or river, where more strength is needed to handle currents.
- Swim in designated swimming areas supervised by a lifeguard.
- Never swim alone.
- If you do get caught in a current, don't try to fight it; stay calm and float with it, or swim parallel to the shore until you can swim free.
- Don't push or jump on others.
- Don't dive in unfamiliar areas.
- Never drink alcohol when swimming; alcohol is involved in about half of all male teen drownings, according to KidsHealth.org.
- Learn CPR and rescue techniques.
- Lifeguards aren't babysitters; always keep your eyes on your child.
- Don't let children play around drains or suction fittings.



Rip currents are powerful currents of water moving away from shore. They can sweep even the strongest swimmer away from shore. If at all possible, swim near a lifeguard.
